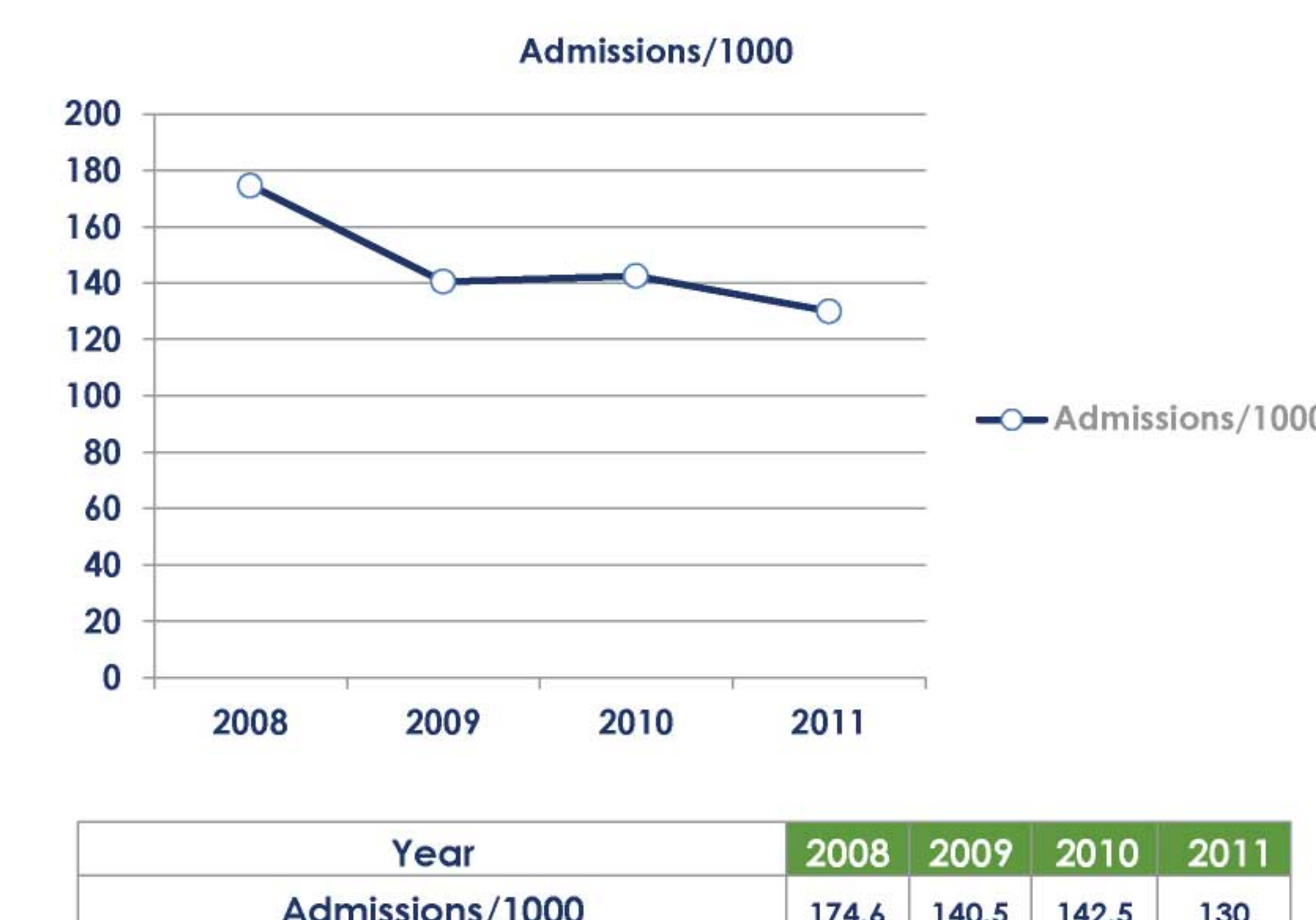
Understanding the impact of trauma across all aspects of the child's life is critical. Our goal is to shift focus toward trauma awareness as a key component of the overall system of care for children in foster care.

Key Results from Cenpatico's PMUR Experience

For more than three years, we have achieved significantly improved outcomes for children in Texas foster care, as well as positively impacted the psychotropic prescribing patterns of individual providers. Most recently, the Texas FY 2011 data indicate:

- Number of foster children receiving at least 1 psychotropic medication for at least 60 days decreased from 20.5% in FY2010 to 19.3% in FY2011 even though the foster care population increased by 5.6%;
- Number of children with class polypharmacy decreased by 11.1%; and
- Number of children prescribed five or more psychotropic medications decreased by 20%.
